We invite all children to attend Sunday School each week. Beacon of Hope offers Sunday School for children in Kindergarten-12th grade. Classes start at 9:00am each Sunday morning and are held on the second floor. Nursery time is available for children under kindergarten age in Room 103.

Nursery: Volunteers are in the nursery to watch the children, during the *Sunday School hour from 9:00am-10:00am*.

Mere Christianity: At 9:00am, all are welcome to join Dustin and Jamie in the Narthex for a study of *Mere Christianity* by C.S. Lewis. This is not a book club (so no need to purchase the book, unless you want to!), but rather a dive into the basics of our Christian faith and spirituality.

Junior Church: Children are welcome to join us any Sunday for Junior Church. They are dismissed from the worship service following the offertory to attend Junior Church. Starting in March, the children will be learning about the days of creation. They will learn about a different day of creation each week. This lesson series will run approximately until the end of April. Come join us Sundays at 10:30am.

- Group of 3 couples, ideally ranging in age and years of marriage meeting together regularly according to demand and schedules (ideally twice a month) to share, challenge, and encourage each other's marriages or relationships
- Share victories, failures, things that work and don't work, to strengthen each other's marriages and relationships
